N.E.R.D.S. v2.0 Crime Drama Superhero Comedy

The N.E.R.D.S. are back as the world faces a new threat...The apocalypse.

N.E.R.D.S. v2.0 is planned to be a film sequel, based in London, England, two years after the first. Though more of the world faces a threat this time (Europe) following the team of socially-inept genius' aiding the lead character in his task of changing the law. Essentially, the team use science and their rich benefactor to create a superhero. The UK government now support the heroes, but other nations are still very sceptical.

Following the events of the first film, the team are excited for more, whether or not they are paid for their troubles. Jake is very reluctant, to the point he wants to give up and initially does, against the wishes of the rest of the team.

The remaining N.E.R.D.S. continue to fight relatively minor crime compared to their last mission, taking down drug dealers, human traffickers etc. Casper (temporarily) steps into Jake's super-shoes as the face/leader of the group.

Black Kat is disappointed with Jake's decision, but accepts it, even though she continues to take part as well, as the actual leader, commanding respect.

Jake begins to wallow in boredom and, ultimately, depression. Harrison is helping him through this and is seen (or at least implied to be) hitting the gym, getting ripped himself (Harrison) and encourages Jake to join him.

Jake declines and begins to fall back into his old part-boy lifestyle.

That is when the anarchists mentioned at the end of the first film (Famine, War, Pestilence & Death), know as The Four Horsemen, strike. They start their coordinated attack on food sources within the country. This inevitably causes panic among the public, but the N.E.R.D.S. try to fix this. Many citizens end up in hospital.

While this issue is still going on, but starting to be contained, the anarchists unleash various diseases in the water supplies and in "oxygen" tanks and "saline" bags used to treat patients.

It is at this point the N.E.R.D.S. really begin to struggle and (some of) the public start to turn against them (again). They beg Jake to return, who is eventually convinced to take up his post, joined this time by Harrison. Harrison proves to be very popular among the N.E.R.D.S. (as a little dig against Jake).

Given the new revelations (Jake's return and famine/disease), civil war breaks out on the streets of Britain. There are ordinary citizens fighting, as well as more creative responses (inspired by the N.E.R.D.S.) on both sides. During this time BattleUnicorn (aka Lai) and Phil join the team.

There is confusion over who is now the leader and it is agreed among the team that there will be a vote, though it shall be "one of the beneficiaries of the Chadwell estate". Casper is voted on, only Casper raises his hand. He looks quite upset with this, whereas Jake is smug. Jake is voted on, only Jake raises his hand. Jake is confused by this. He looks to Black Kat for support "Sorry, butt-face..." she says with typical sass.

With the votes at 1-1 for Casper and Jake, Jake says "So what now? We're all voted on..." and Black Kat responds "Oh...Not all, not yet. All in favour of Harrison!". All other hands, including a reluctant Harrison go up. Jake is stunned and Prophecy explains "He has extensive military experience and we are at war".

Although Harrison is now deemed to lead the team, Jake and Casper are the joint public faces of the group. Harrison leads primarily from the headquarters.

The war is far easier to resolve than the N.E.R.D.S. thought it would have been, even though Jake is attacked with a massive dose of LSD. It leads them into a trap. A death trap. While the team have been so focused on defending the country, they missed that the anarchists were conducting the same actions throughout Europe, blaming the N.E.R.D.S..

As the (highly creative) fight is brought to the UK from Europe (via several methods; air, sea & land), the UK citizens unite to support the N.E.R.D.S., but there are significant casualties. Harrison dies a real hero's death, saving lives in the process. Phil also dies.

This enrages Casper and Jake (once he recovers from his LSD induced dreamworld), spurring him on to kick ass. The N.E.R.D.S. overcome the barrage of violence, proving beyond doubt the guilt of The Four Horsemen. Jake wants to kill the anarchists and is just about to when Black Kat convinces him not to, because it would be against what Harrison stood for.

The Four Horsemen are arrested and charged as terrorists. Most of Europe now supports the N.E.R.D.S., and many want to join. Casper turns down Lai, who asks him to be her boyfriend in Black Kat style, but only because he is gay. He asks Doc Brown to be his boyfriend and he accepts. Jake is shocked, as he did not know either was gay, no one else is remotely surprised.

In a post-script scene, the viewer witnesses a very wealthy American tech owner (think Samuel L Jackson's character in Kingsman / Elon Musk) viewing the scenes from various news sources. He is clearly very impressed, though extremely jealous of what the N.E.R.D.S. have achieved.
